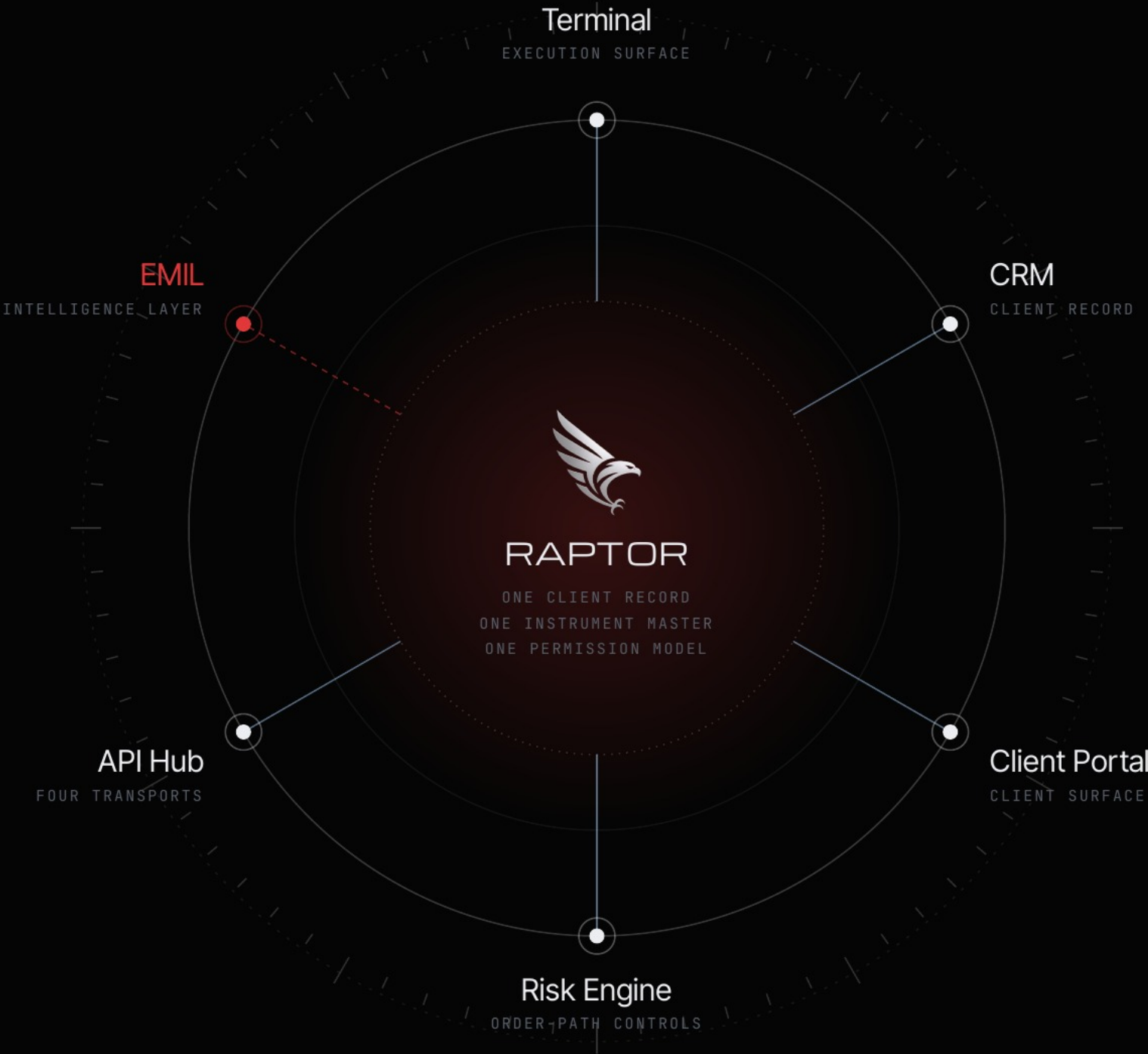

THE ECOSYSTEM

One connected ecosystem.

Not a suite of products that were integrated later. One system with several surfaces, sharing one client record, one instrument master and one permission model.

EMIL observes the CRM, execution and connectivity tiers. Anything it proposes passes the same risk checks as a human order.

20 indigenous modules.

Every module is RAPTOR-native. MT5 and cTrader are migration bridges only — not dependencies.

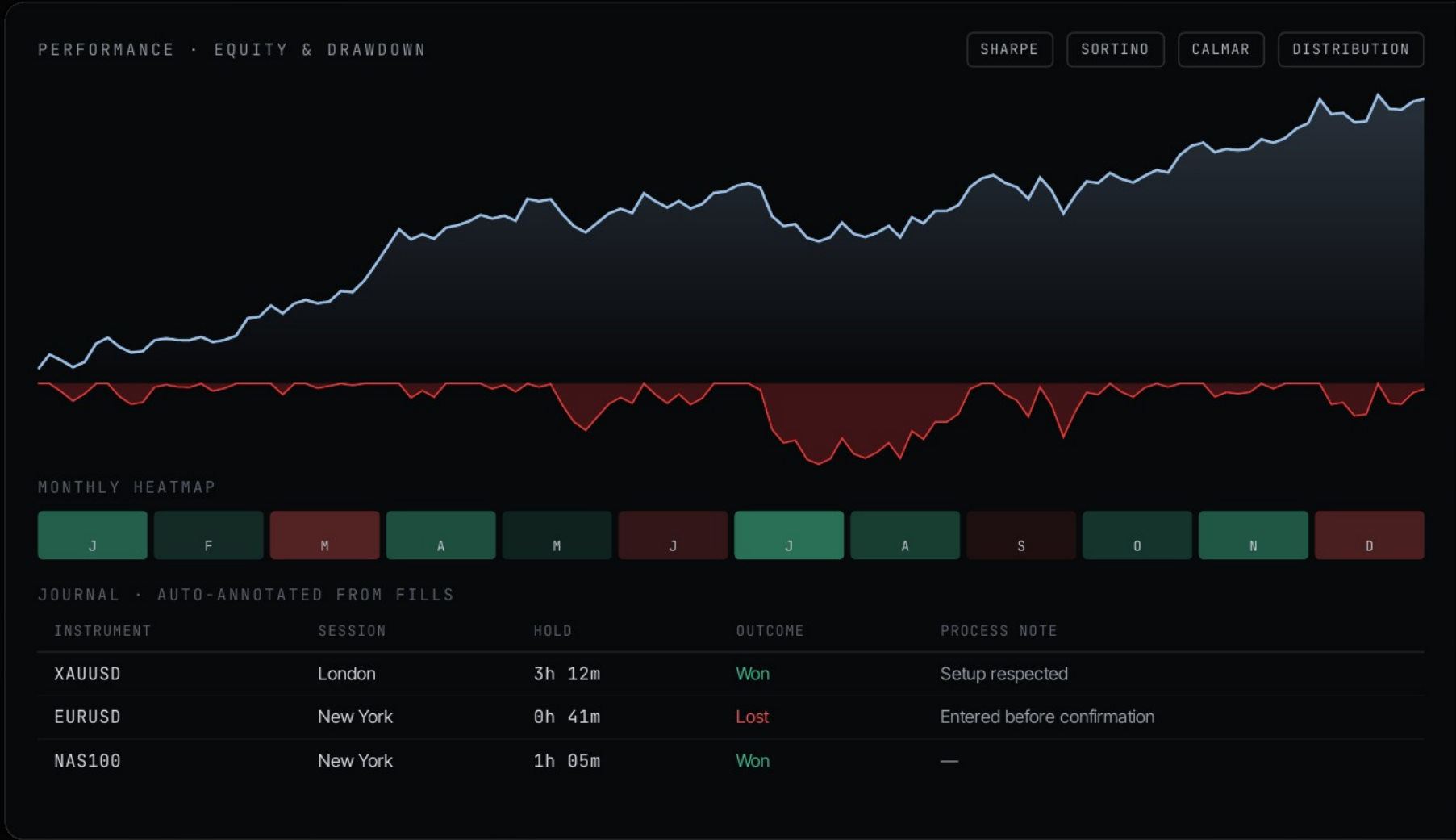

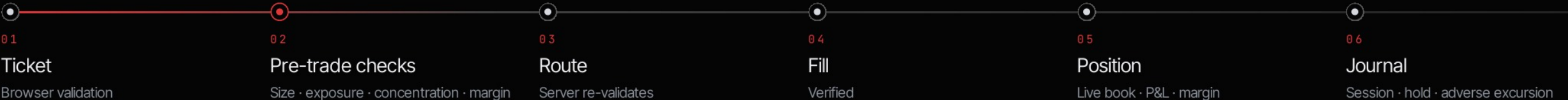

RISK & CONTROL

Before you chase return, know your exposure.

Most damaging positions were not obviously large. They were correlated, concentrated, or held into a session that behaves differently. Raptor makes that shape visible — and puts the controls in the order path rather than in a policy document.

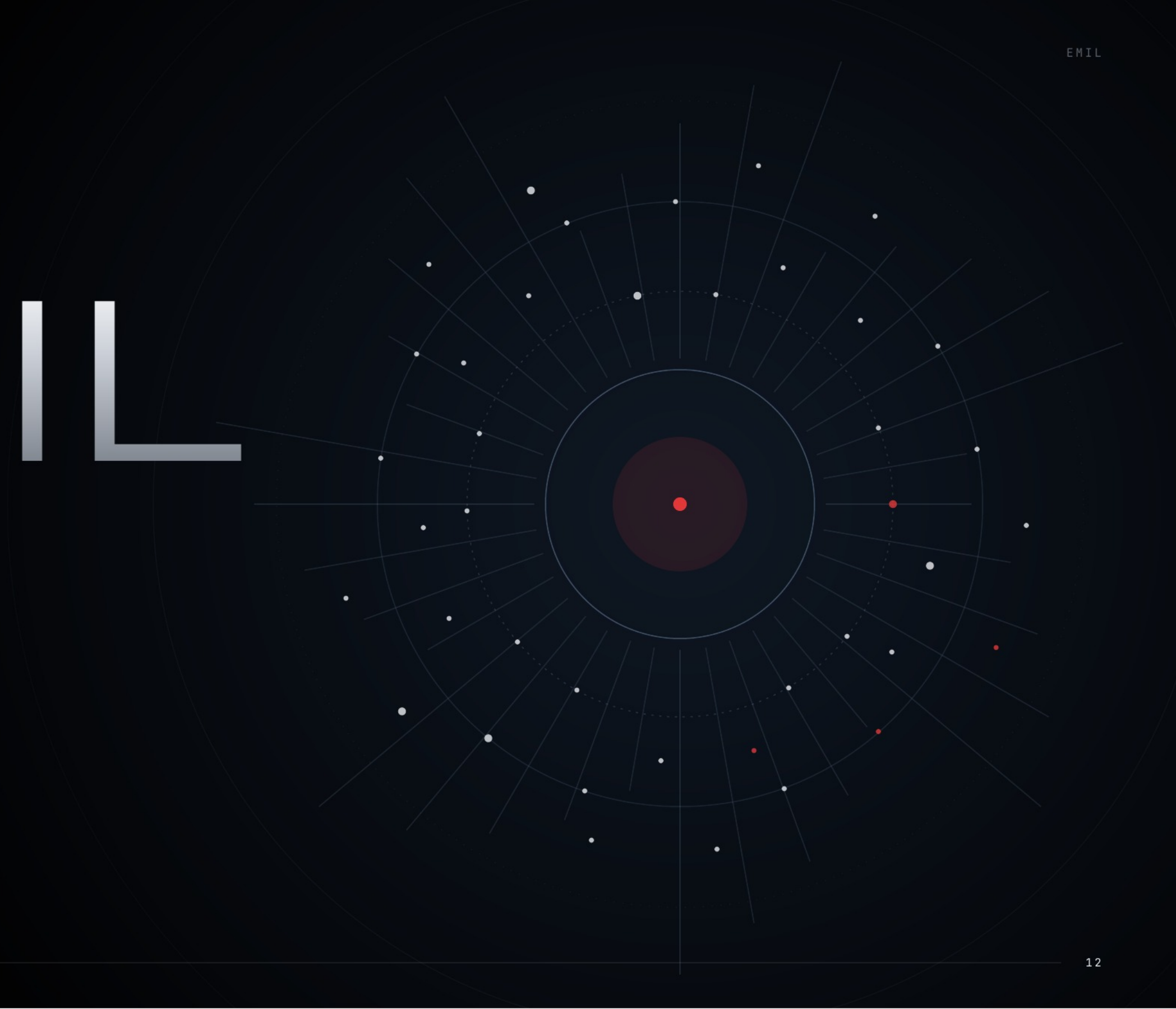

Observe. Understand. Adapt. Protect. Act.

01 · OBSERVE

It watches what you cannot watch continuously.

Price, spread, volatility, session state, exposure and cross-asset relationships — not to predict them, but to notice when they change.

02 · UNDERSTAND

Conditions, stated as a reading.

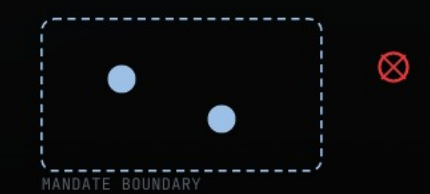

Exposure, concentration and drawdown limits are evaluated in the order path. Nothing inside EMIL can widen them.

Only inside a mandate you wrote and confirmed by typing ARM, with the permissions you granted, while armed.

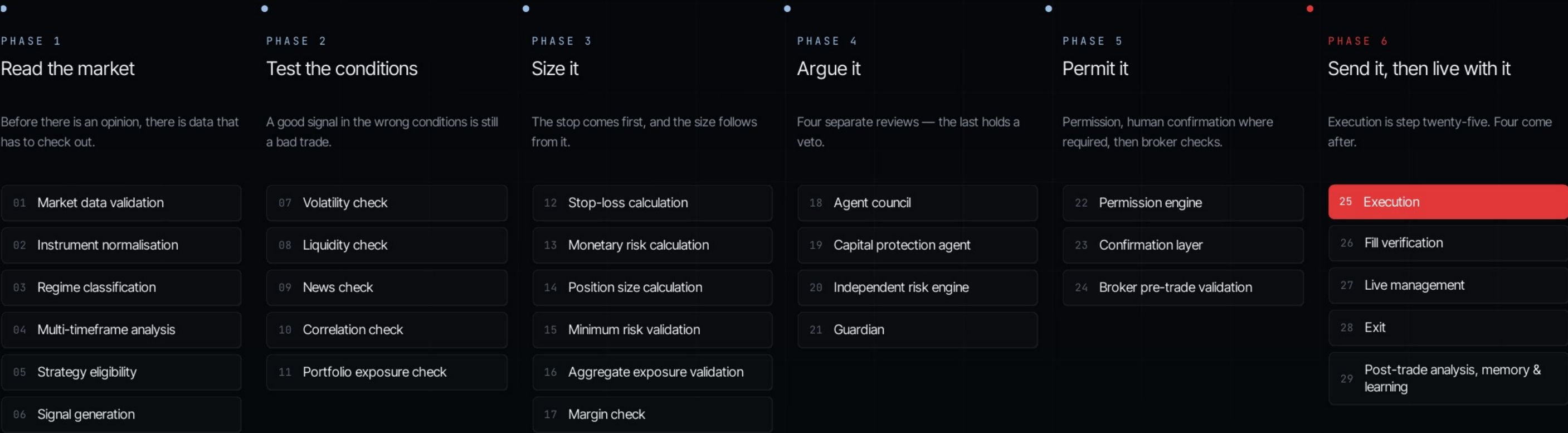
The fifth only happens once you have armed it. Every event is logged in plain language — refusals included. Adaptation changes what EMIL thinks; it never changes what EMIL is allowed to do.

HOW EMIL THINKS

Execution is step twenty-five of twenty-nine.

A proposal has to survive the whole pipeline before an order exists, and each step can stop it. Nothing here is a confidence score standing in for a check.



A decision is the position the council reaches, not the output of one model. The guardian sits outside it — and there is no confidence score that overrides a veto.

THE COUNCIL

A desk of forty,
and one that can say no.



ITS OWN JUDGEMENT

Confidence in a setup is not trust in
the environment.



THE RULE

High setup confidence can never override low environment trust. EMIL reduces risk, requires confirmation, or stands down — and says which number was responsible.

A dedicated novelty detector watches for behaviour that matches no learned regime. On extreme novelty, EMIL enters capital-protection behaviour regardless of how attractive any single setup appears. (The application's own example.)

OPERATING MODES · ACTIVATION

Nine modes. Five can act.
It cannot turn itself on.

Observation	NO EXECUTION	Analyse and learn. No execution.
Advisory	NO EXECUTION	Direction, entry, stop, targets, size and reasoning.
Confirmation	NO EXECUTION	Prepares a complete trade; you approve each one.
Assisted	CAN ACT	You enter; EMIL manages what it was authorised to.
Semi-Autonomous	CAN ACT	Only approved strategies, assets, sessions and limits.
Autonomous	CAN ACT	Scan, enter, manage, hedge, exit — inside hard permissions.
Management Only	CAN ACT	No new directional trades; protect, reduce, close.
Capital Protection	CAN ACT	Only actions that reduce account risk.
Emergency	NO EXECUTION	Stop new exposure immediately.

Arming is deliberate: a disclosure of what the system cannot do, a review of fifteen limits, four acknowledgements — then typing ARM. Disarming is one button, always visible, with no confirmation.

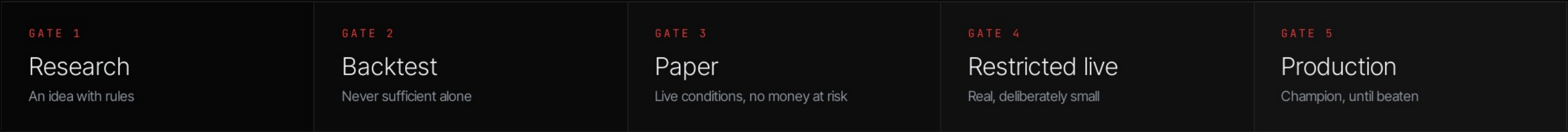

Champion vs challenger

A challenger replaces a champion only after outperforming it across regimes in paper and restricted live — never on backtest results alone.

Degradation is acted on

Versioned, health-scored out of a hundred, watched for drift. A degraded strategy has its sizing halved, then is suspended from new entries.

It will not fill a gap

A candidate missing a rule is marked incomplete and names the rule. Estimates are labelled estimates. A thin backtest is called thin.

BROKER SOLUTIONS · RAPTOR CRM

Every client relationship, *in context.*

A CRM that does not know a client just took a loss, or that their withdrawal is pending verification, is a contact list. Raptor CRM reads the trading and funding state directly — the CRM record *is* the client record.

- Lead pipeline — sources, stages, ownership, conversion
- KYC and document state with the audit trail compliance needs
- Deposits, withdrawals and transfers with processing state
- Calls, emails and notes on the record, not in an inbox

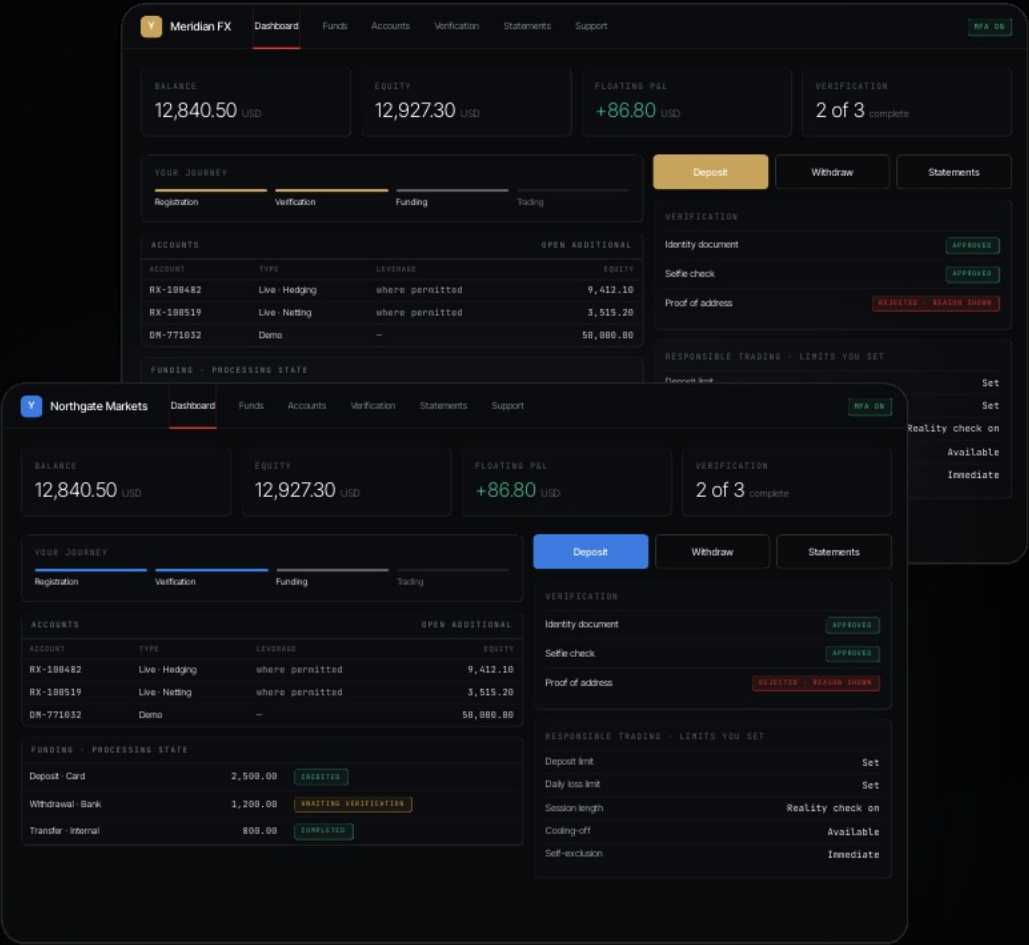

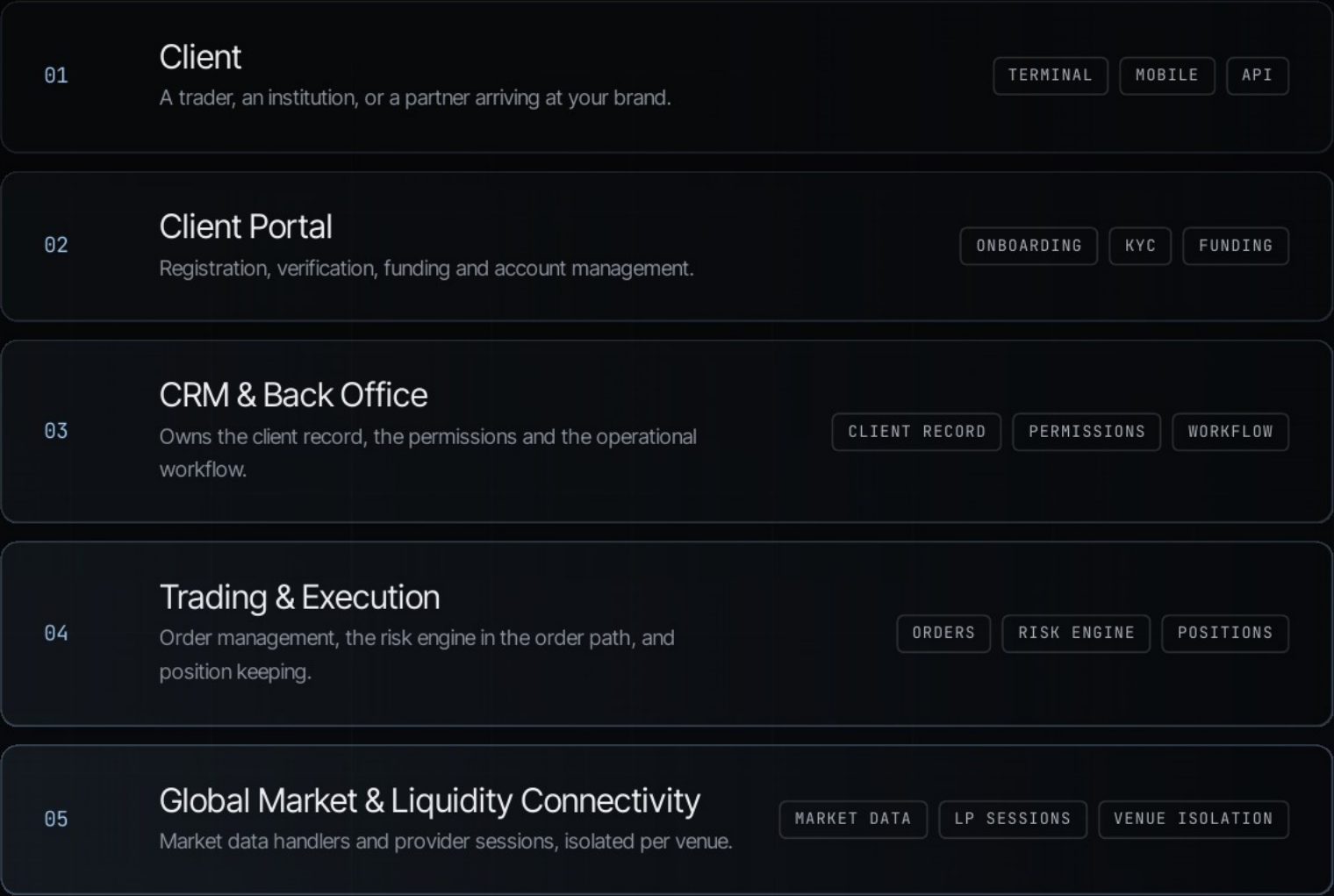

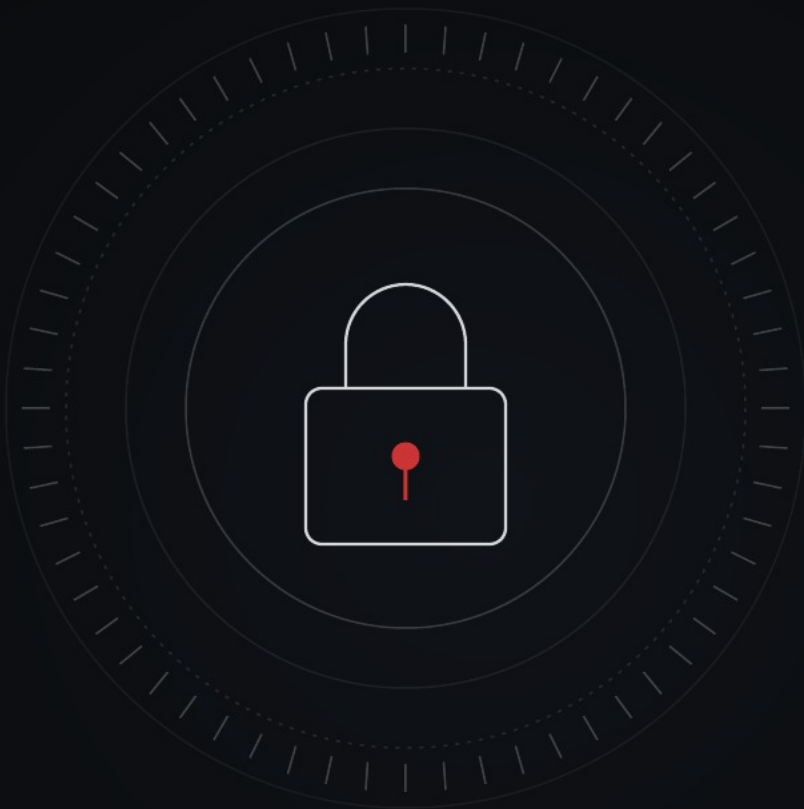
